

GUEST OPERATOR PERMIT APPLICATION

Members of foreign amateur radio organizations who wish to operate in Bali should obtain a permit from the Indonesian Amateur Radio Organization (ORARI) before they are allowed to commence amateur radio activity in call area 9, the province of Bali.

Guest operator permit in call area 9, the province of Bali, will be given to:

1. Members of amateur radio organizations from countries that have reciprocal agreement with Indonesia. These countries include: Australia, Argentine, Belgium, Canada, Czech Republic, United Kingdom, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, the Netherlands, Sweden, and the USA.
2. Members of amateur radio organizations from ASEAN countries. These countries include: Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore, the Philippines, Brunei, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, and Vietnam.

The documents needed for the permit application include the following:

1. Copy of valid amateur radio license
2. Copy of valid passport
3. Two (2) pieces of passport-size photos
4. Local address in Bali
5. Application permit fee of Rp. 100,000

The guest operator permit will allow the amateur radio operator these privileges:

The guest operator can operate at an amateur radio station belonging to a local amateur radio operator while being accompanied by the local station licensee. (Note that this license does not permit the foreign operator to erect a station.)

The permit is valid for the duration of 14 days from the day it is issued and it is extendable.

Extension/renewal fee is Rp. 50,000 and it will be valid for another 14 (fourteen) days.

The guest operator permit is not an amateur radio license and it is only valid for call area 9 in the province of Bali.
